

AETNA BETTER HEALTH[®] OF FLORIDA HEALTHY KIDS EXPANSION

American Therapy Administrators of Florida/Health Network One (ATA-FL/HN1) will be the mandatory specialty network for physical therapy, speech therapy and occupational therapy services provided in a free-standing outpatient setting (i.e. POS 11), for Aetna Better Health[®] of Florida Healthy Kids enrolled members in the expansion counties listed below.

Expansion Coverage Area Implementation schedule:

Region 9 (Palm Beach, Martin & St. Lucie) and Region 11	April 1, 2019

Claims Submission:

Please submit your paper claims to ATA-FL/HN1 at P.O. Box 350590, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33335-0590; or submit your Electronic Claims (EDI) via Payer ID is 65062 for professional claims and 12k89 for institutional claims. You must submit all claims, including all services provided and reflect the accurate number of units. Along with your submittal of claims, providers may be required to submit written documentation such as prior existing orders, prior authorizations and treatment plan/plan of care, in order to receive payment on their claim.

Continuation of Care (COC)

The member's COC period is as follows:

NEW AREAS	EFFECTIVE DATE	COC PERIOD
Region 9 (Palm Beach, Martin & St. Lucie) and Region 11	April 1, 2019	30 days beginning April 1, 2019

COC period is up to 30 days from each effective date listed in the above grid or until a new treatment plan has been developed, whichever comes first. During COC you are not required to obtain an authorization from ATA-FL/HN1 to provide services, but you must submit all claims and reflect the accurate number of units rendered with a copy of your prior authorization. If you feel the member will require continued services, to ensure there is no break in care, you **must** submit a new intake form and supporting documents to ATA-FL/HN1 **prior to the end** of the COC period. Your new authorization period will begin immediately following the COC end date.

Region 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, Okeechobee and Indian River
